

Producer Notes: Certified VEQPRD (Gov. Sparkling Quality Certification) . Produced using the "Bica Aberta" (fermentation off skins) method to separate the solids before fermentation in a temperature controlled stainless steel vats followed by second fermentation in bottle.

Tasting Notes: A traditional method fizz comes from Bairrada's limestone-laced soils. The grapes well balance each other off, skipping along a tight base with pear, quince marmalade, yellow apple, biscuit, meadow herbs with darts of oxidative notes. The finish is brisk and scented with delicate yellow blossoms.

Tasting Notes: Fresh and clear with deep pink colour. Fine bubbles fresh fruit aroma, notes of strawberry. In mouth, elegant and structured with fine and persistent bubbles, giving a delicate sparkling rosé.

The grapes are pressed at low pressure, in a pneumatic press, and then sent to a decantation vats for fermentation at controlled temperatures between 15 to 17 degrees.

Producer Notes: The grapes comes from 30 year old vines planted at 700 meters above sea level. The grapes were manually harvested, destemmed and pressed. The fermentation occurred during 7 days in the traditional granitic stone tanks with foot treading. After the alcoholic fermentation the wine was transferred into stainless steel vats for malolactic fermentation.

Tasting Notes: Ruby, fruity and elegant, well balanced wine with acidity and freshness, rounded tannins with structure and a long finish.

Producer Notes: The grapes are from the 40 year old vine yards located in the Sub-Region of Terras de Senhorim between the Dão and Mondego river, planted at altitude of 400 to 500m in granite soils. The grapes are destemmed and directly pressed in a pneumatic press. Fermentation in stainless steel vats at controlled temperature and careful maceration for better expression of typical characteristics of the grape varieties.

Tasting Notes: Ruby, red fruits, with mineral nose, lively, fresh fruity with balanced acidity and soft tannins.



Producer Notes: The 80 year old vines are located 155km from Atlantic coast at 690m altitude with temperature fluctuations between very hot in the summer and windy and snowy in winter. The grapes were hand harvested in September, destemmed and crushed directly into a vat for 3 days cold soak; alcoholic fermentation was at 12°C and ends at 32°C. Malolactic fermentation in used French oak barrels. Aged for 6 months in used French oak barrels.

Tasting Notes: Stemming from organic viticulture, this wine offers moderate acidity. It unveils scents of cherry and raspberry. This is a silky and expressive fresh wine with great finish.

Tasting Notes: Powerful with superb structure, good finish, freshness with richness and concentration. Pale yellow in color with aromas of citric and pineapple,. It finishes with a fruity burst. Perfectly balanced, it will hold hold well for several years.

Tasting Notes: "An expressive and intense fresh wine with great concentration, balanced fruit, a solid mid-palate, elegant minerality and long finish. Drink it now or hold it."

Tasting Notes: "An elegant wine with notes of red fruit and a touch of oak. Structured palate, with a long finish. It can be consumed immediately or in the next 10 years."

Producer Notes: A field blend from 80 year old small plot vine yards grown at altitude between 250m to 600 meter on north east side of river at Vila Nova de Foz Côa . All field work is practically done by hand without the use of herbicides or pesticides. The grapes are stomped in a small lagars, spontaneous fermentation for 30 days. It was aged for 15 months in used oak barrels.

Tasting Notes: "Another super offering, this one is in blockbuster style with big fruit and plenty of power too. The very expressive fruit has a slightly darker feel in this vintage, but it also is plenty delicious. Then, it adds the pure power yet is never really astringent. It is well constructed, as always. This may be the best yet, but put it away for a couple of years, at least. This should easily do 20 years, but probably more.."

Tasting Notes: Wine has aromas of ripe fruit, cherry and raspberry and light floral notes. Knit, tannins contain the spicy blackcurrant and ripe, juicy cherry and berry. The finish is harmonious, leaving excellent fruity sensations of mineral.

Producer Notes: Grapes are lightly crushed and moved by gravity into temperature regulated steel tanks and large oak barrels and fermented at 27°C with two pump-overs per day. Indigenous yeast fermentation and post fermentation maceration of 21 days.

The winery is located in Portalegre, a sub-region of Alentejo, The terroir is known for its cooler climate.

Tasting Notes: Concentrated purple color, intense floral nose with notes of black fruits. Mouth feel is full bodied, rich in flavor, with smooth tannins.

Producer Notes: All bunches are passed over a sorting table and subjected to intensive quality control. The grapes are gently crushed and moved by gravity into temperature regulated steel vats. Both alcoholic and malolactic fermentation occurred naturally with no inoculation. The post fermentation maceration on skins lasted for 28 days. Aged for 16 months in new French oak barrels.

Tasting Notes: Deep purple colour, attractive on the nose, showing intense and pure aromas of fresh red fruit and notes of violets. Engaging on the palate, with fresh, finely textured tannins, and intense notes of red berry fruit with soft hints of chocolate. It finishes with great freshness and persistence.

Producer Notes: Made by the old traditional method of making Alentejo whites by using the original grape varieties from the region. The grapes come from 2 vineyards: Vinha da Nora (60%) with 35+ years old vines and organically farmed since 2015, and Vinha de Vale do Cepo (40%) with 47+ years old vines. The grapes are hand harvested between 3am to 4am in the morning than whole bunch pressed, cold decanted without any additives and fermented. Low intervention throughout the cycle and no malolactic fermentation.

Tasting Notes: "Offers full, honeyed aromas, with hints of beeswax, citrus and ripe stone fruit. The vibrant, tangy palate has a mouth filling texture, plus exuberant acidity that gives a super-crisp finish. Fresh and preserved citrus, juicy grapefruit and candied peel".

Producer Notes: Produced in the hot and dry Mediterranean climate of the southern part of Portugal. It is an area known for producing naturally low yields of concentrated grapes. Sustainably farmed in the rocky schist soils. Grapes from vineyards aged from 7 to 50 years. Grapes were hand picked, hand sorted, sliced, and fermented with indigenous yeasts. After native fermentation in vats for 20 days, aged 10 months French oak barrel (50%) and steel vats 50%.

Tasting Notes: "A rather substantial offering. It might even be better in time; shows fine depth, beautiful fruit and hints of finesse. The tannins are ripe, making this easy to enjoy. For the regular Tinto this is a steal and a fine value point. It's a great choice for a house pour. It will hold a reasonable time and can still improve."

Tasting Notes: "Fresh and elegant and it finishes with a burst of lovely fruit. Concentrated in flavors, leaning to red and black fruits, this is almost silky in texture and very graceful. It seems fairly ready to drink now—and pretty irresistible—but it will certainly improve over a year or two."

Hand picked, fermented 30% whole bunch and 70% destemmed, gravity in vat. Spontaneous fermentation, for 25 to 40 days, and aged for 18 months in 3 year old French oak barrels.

Tasting Notes: "Silky, flavorful and precise, this is a beauty with fruit and sunny demeanor makes it a winner. It has the structure to age. Elegant and it finishes with a burst of lovely fruit. Concentrated in flavors, leaning to red and black fruits, this is almost silky in texture."

Producer Notes: The grapes have been produced by the same family for 6 generations. These grapes come from 40 year old vines planted with equal proportions of Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca and Tinta Roriz. Grapes were harvested early September, foot trodden, and fermented in traditional granite/schist with 40% whole cluster and 30% whole cluster in stainless-steel tanks. Fermentation was done with indigenous yeasts with long skin contact. The wine is aged for 12 months in used French oak barrels and malolactic fermentation was in the used French oak barrels.

Tasting Notes: "Harmonious piece balanced out against the others. Rock roses, plum, dusky wild blueberry, lifted violets, cassis thorns run the lighter palate, framed by very fine, tight and persistent tannins to a fine, salty, lingering finish. A very welcome 12.5 degrees alcohol reassures that Douro reds can be elegant, delicate, and complex."

Producer Notes: This top cuvée comes from an 80-90 year old field blend vineyards at altitude of 300-350m on Schist. It has over different varieties with the principal ones being Touriga Franca, Tinta Roriz, Tinta Carvalha, Tinto Barca and Alicante Bouschet. Grapes were picked in early September and fermented with indigenous yeast only, in open cement tank with 60% whole cluster with long skin contact. The wine is aged for 21 months in 500L used French oak barrels where malolactic fermentation took place.

Tasting Notes: "Fresh and mineral-led, with layers of sapid plum, wild raspberry, scrubby rock rose resins, graphite, worn leather, and wax. Tannins are fine. The finish lingers with a dusting of pink peppercorns. Beautiful minerality and vibrancy This wine is drinking well now, and will reward with cellar time."

Producer Notes: Manually harvested in September, before pressing the grapes were de-stemmed and crushed, press was done without prior maceration, the wine was decanted at low temperature for 24 hours, indigenous yeast fermentation, 70% of the wine ageing took place in used 225L and 500L French oak barrels for 8 months and 30% of the wine fermented and aged in stainless steel vats. No malolactic fermentation. All grapes are from vineyards aged between 35 and 60 year.






